FABRICS

- Compact canvas in linen/wool blends.
- Tweedies, gravitationally flecked, slubbed, visible rustic yarns.
- Velvets, moleskins, sueded-aspects, felts, needlepunchings.
- Blended wools, cashmere.

- Hairy, fur-lined and sheepskin products to work with from the front or back.
- Knits and wovens made from rag-rug style ribbon yarns, visibly recycled.
- Contrasting double faces, double weaves.

COLOURS


- Green shades, warm khakis.
- Green casts, combinations of greenish hues.
- 1980's blues.



- Raw or natural wool buttons.
- Suede, split leather and natural leather labels.
- Verdigris rivets.
- Mottled, battered-looking hang tags.
- Thick labels made from used felt.
- Compressed buttons in a recycled spirit.
- Back packs, utility bags.



- Shading in the darkness.
- Thickly coating with matt magma, almost totally eclipsing.
- Unearthed, as if dug up after 100 years, effects.
- Bottom edges dipped in dirty snow.
- Full collages with engineered abrasions and floating yarns.
- Bumpy surfaces.
- Dishevelled, torn-out, ratiné effects.
- 'Acid-fog' worn aspects.

FABRICS

- Heavy suppleness, thick washed structures, diagonals.
- Silk and Lyocell blends.
- Voluminous, ultra-stretch 3/1 twills and jerseys.
- Knit/woven dual-fabric combinations.
- Metalloplastic yarn blends.
- Constellation jaquards.
- Weightlessly-fine quiltings.
- Chunky knits.

COLOURS

- Greys step in for blacks.
- Touches of lively, intergalactic colour.
- Supernova fusions, sun spots.

FINISHING

- Constellation fantasies with multi-techniques, star clusters.
- Putting patches and collages on top, cosmic open-work appliqués.
- Pale-dark-pale graduations.
- Writing in stardust in dark on light, or in light on dark.
- Astral-ray washes and giant halos.
- Thread-like embroideries and patterns, starry patterns.
- Localised, uneven pleats.
- Fringing.

ACCESS RIES



- Iridescent labels.
- Starry-sky shine.
- Square studs and faceted studs to scatter.
- Filigreed and finely metalworked buttons and jewels.
- Micro-rivets and colourful snaps.
- Planets and celestial objects for buttons and pins.
- Large rhinestones

FITS



- Flared women's overalls and pants.
- Very high waists.
- Sheath skirts.
- 3/4 jackets and coats, trench coats.
- Mid-leg pleats.
- Long indigo knits.



- Partial transparencies, glazings, silicones, resins.
- Fine and supple skin-like coatings matt, chic, in graduated colours.
- Diagrams of space engines, technical drawings.

ACCESSORIES


- Giant zips.
