Maxwell Davidson Gallery was founded in 1968 and has been a member of the Art Dealers Association of America since 1975. The gallery emphasizes Modern, postwar, and contemporary paintings, drawings, and sculpture with a strong focus on Kinetic and Optic art.

The gallery represents Carlos Cruz-Diez, Pedro S. de Movellan, Tim Prentice, the Estates of Tom Wesselmann, George Segal, and Mary Ann Unger, and is also the pre-eminent dealer for the works of George Rickey, for whom the gallery has mounted 16 one-man exhibitions. In addition to an expanding contemporary program, the gallery has had one-man exhibitions for Henri Matisse, Fernand Léger, Raoul Dufy, Roberto Matta, and Sam Francis.

The stable of contemporary artists that the gallery represents is international, with a concentration on young American and British artists who work in a wide variety of media. In 2014, the Maxwell Davidson Gallery will open a new multi-level location at 521 West 26th Street in Chelsea, New York.
